Pompey Pool League Double Rules.

Doubles will be played as per the normal game and playing rules except that each pair of players take alternate shots at each visit to the table – even at the break or when two shots are granted.

When playing and you legally pot a ball, your team's visit continues. Your partner takes the next shot. You and your partner continue to alternate shots until the visit is over.

If shots are not played in turn, a foul will be awarded to the opposing team

Talking between Team Members is allowed before the Team has taken control of The Table. Subsequent discussion between Team Members is not permitted, except when the colour of balls to be to be played for is in question. if any further talking occurs, a foul will be awarded to the opposing team.

A Team takes control of the table when they take their first shot in a visit (i.e., when the tip of a player's cue touches the cue ball).

A lag will decide the initial break after which the break will alternate between Teams.

For Doubles Competitions, breaks are to alternate between players as well as alternating between teams (the break shot count as a shot) – e.g. Frame 1: team A, player A. Frame 2: team B, player A. Frame 3: team A, player B. Frame 4: team B, player B. There is no change for any decider, the frames go in turn.

Excessive slow play is considered unsportsmanlike behaviour and will be dealt with in accordance with paragraph 1 of the Blackball Rules of Play.
